**STONEWALL DALLAS DEMANDS RESTORATION OF
LGBTQ+ YOUTH RESOURCES TO DFPS WEBSITE**



DALLAS, TX (Oct 14, 2021) — This week the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services removed vital informational resources for the LGBTQ+ community after yielding to petty Republican gubernatorial primary politics.

“Let’s be clear, Don Huffines is a hateful, out of touch, extreme political bully. Greg Abbott is conforming to that approach for political expediency, which says a lot about his political weakness right now,” said Todd Hill-Jones, President of Stonewall Democrats of Dallas.

“Stripping resources and vital mental health information away from vulnerable LGBTQ+ Texans puts these youth at great risk for severe depression, homelessness, or even suicide. This is the 21st and not the 19th century. LGBTQ+ people and families are here in Texas. We are positive contributors to society, we are economic drivers, and we are taxpayers. Republican bigotry and hatred of our community will not overcome us. We will stand proud and we will fight for equality under the law in the Lone Star State.”
